It is my pleasure to invite you to the fourth ASNC Masterclass in Cardiac Amyloidosis: Diagnosis, Disease Spectrum, and Management. This will be held virtually on March 13th to 15th, 2026, with free registration for all participants.

This masterclass is designed to sharpen your skills in suspecting, diagnosing, treating, and longitudinally managing patients with ATTR cardiac amyloidosis. This program will consist of four virtual two-and-a-half-hour sessions tailored for medical professionals involved in the diagnosis and management of amyloidosis.

As in prior years, the masterclass will include a dedicated session for technologists and clinicians interested in accurate acquisition and processing of cardiac amyloidosis radionuclide imaging, also known as CARI. This will be a focused two-hour session on Saturday, March 14th.

New this year we are introducing and a special dialogue with patients living with ATTR-CM, who will share their personal journey and their own personal efforts to improve community awareness and outreach.

This session promises to be both instructive and inspiring, and I believe it will further motivate all of us to expand engagement around this increasingly prevalent disease.

The masterclass represents a unique opportunity to learn from international experts with extensive experience and deep expertise in amyloidosis care. I encourage you and your multidisciplinary care teams to learn the best practices across the spectrum of care for patients with amyloidosis.
